

I will be out of town November 12th and 14th to attend an NSF Principle Investigator meeting in DC. Instead of cancelling class for both days, on Friday, I would like you to do the following.

You will meet in groups of three or four to do proposal evaluation. You will be grading the (improved) proposals on the same standards as I originally graded them and one additional criterion (that of an overall rating).

1. You are to send your proposal to the group of students who will be evaluating your proposal. This must be sent by Wednesday (the 12th, midnight).
2. You are to receive the proposals by those members of your assigned group and evaluate the proposals before coming to class on Friday.
3. On Friday, as a group of three or four, you will consider the individual member rankings and come up with a final evaluation. For each paper, assemble each individual evaluation and the group evaluation. Turn these into the secretaries to put in my box.

Group A is to evaluate proposals in Group B.

Group B is to evaluate proposals in Group C.

Group C is to evaluate proposals in Group A.
